Note to Physicians and Pharmacists: Commercial and some Medicare Advantage plans may reimburse for NARCAN® under the medical benefit using code J3490: Unlisted drug. Medicare may reimburse for NARCAN® under the medical benefit using code G2215: Take home supply of nasal NARCAN®; 2-pack of 4 mg per 0.1 ml nasal spray for Medicare beneficiaries only. Providers must submit both the appropriate National Drug Code and dosage in the claim's notes section.
